

Individual Utah taxpayers can claim a 5 percent Utah state income tax credit on UESP account contributions up to a certain amount for each account beneficiary who was younger than age 19 when designated as such on an account. If the beneficiary age requirement is met, you can claim the tax credit every year that you contribute for the life of the account.

### Free Back-to-School Kit
